Nomination process

Applicants will be first selected by their home universities to be part of this international exchange program at Universidad Autónoma de Chile, within the framework of a specific student exchange agreement between both institutions.

Nomination of applicants will be made and informed by the international Relations coordinator at your home institution by email to internacional@uautonoma.cl providing the following infromation:

- Name of home university
- Student's full name
- Area of study



- Exchange period: first term 2025 (from March to July 2025) or full year (from March to December 2025)
- Student 's email

Nomination start date: October 7th, 2024. Nomination end date: November 8th, 2024.

Requests

Home university must verify that their nominated student(s) meet the following requirements:

- To be at least in their 5th semester in their Study program.
- To be enrolled and active student at their home university.
- To be aware of the academic and economic implications of doing and exchange semester abroad.
- To have a Spanish level of B2 or higher (no official certificate is required, but the level must be verified by the home university).

Application process

Duly nominated students will receive a link to the application form to be completed and submitted by **November 22nd, 2024.**

Requested documents in application form

- Digital copy of student 's passport.
- Academic Transcript.
- Official nomination letter signed by home university.
- Copy of medical insurance or letter of commitment to purchase medical insurance (covering the entire exchange period, repatriation, sickness and accident).
- Signed letter of commitment by student (attached to application form).

Universidad Autónoma de Chile will send the acceptance letters to aplicants who meet the selection requirements.



Students who have received their acceptance letter must follow the steps indicated in the document "Incoming Mobility Instructions for Foreign Students"

Academic program

- Universidad Autónoma de Chile works with the Chilean Credit Transfer System (STC). Each program of study specifies the number of credits associated with each course. 1 STC is equivalent to 30 chronological hours. For more information about the STC, please visit: SCT - Documentos Disponibles (consejoderectores.cl)
- Each 6-credit course has a weekly dedication time of 10 chronological hours between class hours and self-study, so we do not recommend taking a load of more than 24 credits.
- Practical subjects, annual subjects or subjects that consider clinical field quotas are excluded from this call.
- Students may take subjects from one degree program and up to 2 degree programs, as long as they belong to the same faculty. Taking subjects from different semesters or degree programs could imply problems in taking them for posible overlapping class schedules.

- It is expected that the academic agreement may change during the first 3 weeks
 of the exchange due to scheduling changes, timetable changes, etc. Students
 are responsible for informing the exchange office of those changes. Students are
 responsible for reporting changes to their respective coordinators at their home
 university within that period.
- Each undergraduate program can accept a maximum of 5 exchange students, the quotas will be assigned according to the agreement between the institutions, then by order of application and eligibility of the candidate.
- Students may participate in workshops, webinars, and other University activities; however, certificates of participation will not be issued in any case.

- The International Relations Office (DRI) of Universidad Autónoma de Chile does not manage visa procedures, homologation of vaccinations, or other personal procedures for students.
- DRI does not recommend housing, nor does it endorse housing.
- DRI does not have on-campus student work programs, nor does it offer funding for incoming students in this program.
